COMMANDMENTS AND THE 2 GREATEST

Why do we have laws? To protect us and keep us safe. The same with rules in our home. Parents make house rules because they love you and want to keep everyone physically and emotionally safe.

God also gives us rules because He loves us. The rules He gives us are meant to protect us and others.

1. Have no other gods but God.
2. Do not worship statues.
3. Be careful with God's name.
4. Keep the Sabbath day special.
5. Honor your father and mother.
6. Do not murder.
7. Keep your marriage promises.
8. Do not steal.
9. Do not lie.
10. Do not covet (wish other people's stuff was yours)

In the 10 commandments, there are two that are the most important. "Love God with all your heart and with all your soul" If we love God, we will automatically keep the first four rules.

"Love your neighbor as yourself." If you can follow this rule and love other people the way God wants us to, you won't do anything bad to them, therefore you will follow the other 6 rules!
